
Sir,

On the careful consideration of the inspection report submitted by the Inspection Committee vide letter No. Shiksha-SML(5-2)B/Inspection-13108 Dated 23/07/2012 constituted for the purpose of inspection of Private Educational Institutions of the School level for grant of permission to run/establish a private educational institution by the Govt. Of H.P. Shimla vide Notification No. Shiksha-II- Chha (11)-2/2005-L dated 03-05-2006, and in exercise of the powers vested to me vide Govt. Notification No. Shiksha-II-Chha (5)-3/97 dated 16-01-2007, the approval of competent authority with regard to issue of Permission for establishment/running private Educational Institution" in respect of "**Paramount Public School Educational Society, Utopian Lodge, Engine Ghar, Road Sanjauli Shimla171006**" for the establishment of "**Saraswati Paradise International Public School, H.B. Colony Sanjauli, Shimla-171006 (H.P)**" for 9<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> & 10+1 to 10+2 ( Arts, Commerce & Science) standard from the academic session 2013-14 is conveyed, subject to the following terms and conditions:-

1. that the school concerned shall be affiliated to from **Central Board of Secondary Education Shiksha Kendra, 2, Community Centre, Preet Vihar, Vikas Marg, Delhi-110301** for 9<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> & 10+1 to 10+2 ( Arts, Commerce & Science)classes.
2. that the State Govt. will not provide any type of financial assistance/Grant-in-aid etc., in respect of the said institution.
3. that the admission in the institution shall be made strictly in accordance with the norms as laid down by the Board of School Education to which the school is affiliated and no discrimination on the basis of caste, co lour, creed and sex shall be made. No pupil shall be refused admission on account of his caste creed or religion.
4. that the private institution shall employ only the trained/eligible staff as per the norms fixed by the Govt.
5. that no particular religious education shall be imparted by the institution to maintain secular character of the institution.
6. that the fees and funds shall be such that they are not of exploiting nature but contribute to the spread of education. They should be commensurate to the salary of the staff being paid, development of infrastructure and

- facilities and activities being provided to the students.
7. that the permission to run or establish a private educational institution shall be granted only on individual basis and the institution shall not be entitled to open its branches elsewhere.
  8. that the institution shall maintain proper record of receipts and expenditure and shall submit within six months at the end of the academic year and the report of audit conducted by the Chartered Accountant to the competent authority.
  9. that the institutions shall have to comply with the norms/provisions of the H.P. Private Educational Institutions (Regulation) Act, 1997 and rules notified by the Govt. vide Notification No. Shiksha-II-(Ga) 6-1/98 dated 19-10-2004 and the instructions issued by the competent authority from time to time.
  10. that the society will make efforts to acquire its own land and establish the institution in its own land.
  11. that the school shall have to furnish all information and returns as called for by the Department from time to time.
  12. that the recruitment of the staff will be made after following the proper procedure i.e. by advertisement at least in two leading national daily newspaper or getting sponsorship of names from the nearest employment exchange giving full detail of the qualifications required and scale of pay plus allowance.
  13. that the PTA has been framed by the institution as per norms i.e. with 2/3<sup>rd</sup> members from amongst parents and 1/3<sup>rd</sup> members from amongst teachers.
  14. that the staff have been provided or proposed to be provided the facility of provident fund.


